Staff Reports

Discussion: Alex and Zach talked about past, current and future programs currently going on. Alex talked about the upcoming Krinke Memorial 5K that will start and end at Thorne Rider park. - A. Sheridan Event Center Update: DJ Dearcorn.
- a. Don Julien spoke on behalf of DJ and gave an update on the Sheridan Event Center. They submitted a Grant at the end of August and have a turn around time of 30-45 dates and the latest they should know is by the end of December. The SHS Booster club is leading a pledge donation that would be mentioned at the upcoming high school football game regarding the Sheridan Event Center in the lead up to “Giving Tuesday”. Don mentioned that the Sheridan Recreation District is an important asset to this project and they need our input when it comes to getting what the Center needs with equipment and program ideas for the community. Don will come to the meetings frequently as more information comes to light with the grant funds.
 - b. Arin mentioned that we need to more effectively use the committees to help the staff on a broader level. Arin also asked a question, if we receive feedback from our participants about the programs. Alex mentioned that we are in the process of working on some Co-Creates (4 sections , Adults Recreation, Youth Recreation, Outdoor Recreation, and Park) that the staff will be leading around the start of the new year. Zach talked about how we are starting to work on program audits which will gather more data from surveys that we will send out each time a program ends.

Committee Updates:

- Parks and Recreation Committee
 - Zach mentioned that we have started to discuss if the lights at the outdoor tennis actually work. Steve brought it to our attention when he tried to use them. This was a great way to focus on projects as we are out in our parks. Calls have been made to see what is a timeline we could potentially get those back up in running.
